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Young Scholars' Institute (YSI) is a year-round non-profit learning center that provides educational, cultural and recreational activities for students in grades Pre-K through 12 to strengthen academic skills and overall development.

Program	Grades	Description
College Admissions Workshops	7-12	YSI staff members facilitate two all-day workshops that provide information on college admission, financial aid and career planning for students and parents. A light meal is provided. Registration is required.
College Tours	6-12	Middle and high school students travel and visit college/university campuses and learn about the expectations of college. Tour dates vary.
Cultural Activities	K-12	YSI participants enjoy age appropriate activities, such as attend theatrical productions, visit museums, visit historically important sites and more. Many trips are open to parents.
Edward W. Bullock Career Speaker Series	8-12	Middle and high school students and their parents attend events designed to expose students to various career fields and aid career exploration. Registration is required. Refreshments are served.
Pre-School	Ages 3-5	This ten-month program provides district pre-school children an opportunity to prepare for a successful kindergarten experience. Certified instructors use Creative Curriculum to teach children in a safe and nurturing environment. There is no cost to Trenton families.
Pre-STEM Seminar (Science Technology Engineering & Math)	5-8	The pre-STEM Seminar exposes local middle school students to the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM). The meetings are led by college students and career professionals who facilitate math and science lessons through hands-on activities. The seminar meets two hours per week on the 2 nd and 4 th Saturdays.
Reading Adventures with the Deltas	1-5	The sorors of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. encourage local youth to appreciate the power of reading. The program is held the first Saturday of every month from 10:00a.m.-12:00p.m.
Reading Instruction	1-3	The focus of this course is to help young students improve their reading to achieve grade level proficiency and/or surpass it. Each 2-hour class meets on Saturdays from 10:00a.m.-12:00p.m. except the first Saturday of each month.
SAT/ACT Preparation Course	9-12	Skilled instructors provide math and verbal instruction for the SAT I and the ACT. The course meets after school from 5-8:00p.m. and on some Saturdays from 9:00a.m.-1:00p.m. It is offered several times per year.
Summer Enrichment Program	Pre-K-12	The YSI Summer Enrichment Program provides daily academic instruction in language arts, mathematics and science as well as recreational and cultural activities.
Toastmaster, Inc	5-8	Public speaking exercises transform students into effective communicators. The fall only course meets Saturday from 10:00a.m. – 12:00p.m.
Tutoring	K-12	Volunteer tutors from local colleges and the local professional community provide instructional sessions each week in all subjects. Tutoring takes place on Tuesday and Thursdays from 5:00p.m. – 6:30p.m. and Saturdays from 10:00a.m.-12:00p.m.
