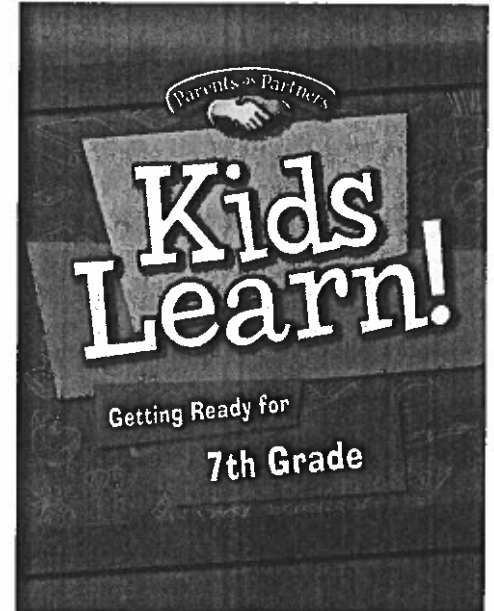

Kids Learn! Getting Ready for 7th Grade: (For returning students)

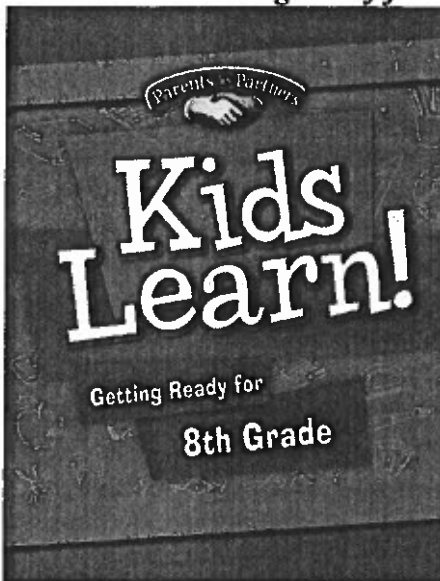
